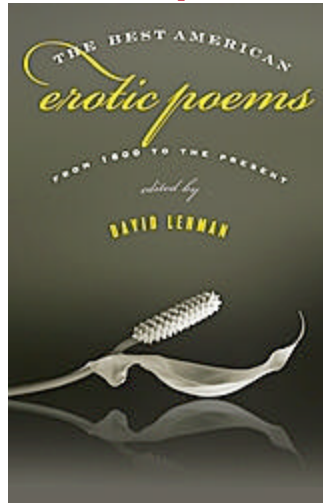
**The Best American Erotic Poems
